HOWARD YACKUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The recipient of the annual Howard Yackus Memorial Scholarship Award will be selected from nominees submitted by Indian and Native American WIOA Section 166 and Public Law 102-477 Grantees. The recipient will be honored at the annual NINAETC Awards Luncheon.

- ▶ Each Grantee may nominate only one (1) participant (current or former) for the Howard Yackus Memorial Scholarship Award.
- ▶ Documentation of American Indian, Alaska Native, Native Hawaiian heritage or tribal affiliation must be submitted.
- ▶ The nominee must submit a recent high-resolution digital photograph (for publication in the program booklet).
- ▶ The nominee must submit verification of current enrollment in a post-secondary educational institution.
- ▶ **The nominee must submit a self-composed essay** on his or her education and career goals and explain how the 166/477 program has helped him or her.
- ▶ Statement of why the nominee is deserving of this award.
