### OUTSTANDING EMPLOYER AWARD

The National Indian and Native American Employment and Training Conference recognizes Outstanding Employers who have not only been helped by the WIOA Section 166 or Public Law 102-477 Program, but have also made a significant contribution to and for Native American people. Selections will be made from nominations submitted by Indian and Native American WIOA Section 166 and Public Law 102-477 Grantees. Recipients will be honored at the annual NINAETC Awards Luncheon.

- ▶ Each Grantee may nominate only one (1) employer (current or former) for an Outstanding Employer Award.
- ▶ Nominee must be a 166/477 employer who, by their commitments, has contributed toward opportunities for the employment of 166/477 participants (within the last 18 months).
- ▶ To be considered for the award, Parts I, II, III, and IV must be completed. Grantee may include supporting materials.
- ▶ Employer logo and/or photograph in high-resolution digital format is required (for publication in the program booklet).
